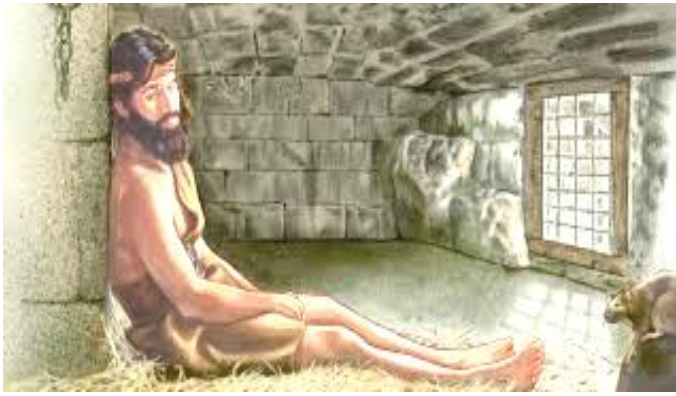

**Diocese of Youngstown**  
**Annual Bishop's Appeal 2021**

This week our parish will be joining parishes throughout the Diocese of Youngstown in asking every Catholic family to support the 2021 Annual Bishop's Appeal. The Appeal is the primary funding source for Catholic Charities in the six counties of our diocese. Especially as we continue to weather the effects of the pandemic, there has been an increase in the number of needy persons coming to Catholic Charities for help, and they depend on our support of the Bishop's Appeal.

The Bishop's Appeal also helps to support our diocesan ministries including seminarian formation and the Office of Vocations, the Office of Catholic Schools, Religious Education, Youth and Young Adult Ministries, and the Catholic Television Network of Youngstown (CTNY).

**Our parish was given an Appeal goal of \$35,100 to contribute towards the Diocesan Goal of \$4 million.** Bishop Bonnar is counting on our support of the 2021 Bishop's Appeal to reach our goal.
