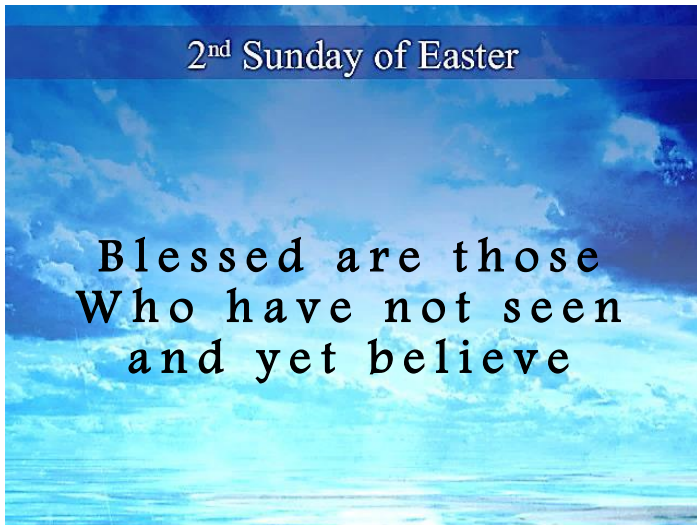

Annual Bishop's Appeal 2021

To date 73 of St. Joseph parish households have contributed \$12,545, with a total commitment of \$16,024 (45%) toward our ***Appeal goal of \$35,100*** towards support of the 2021 Bishop's Appeal and the **Diocesan Goal of \$4 million.** Envelopes can be found at the back of church. Thank you.

Diocesan Wedding Anniversary Celebrations

The first Diocesan **Wedding Anniversary Celebration for 2021 will be Sunday, June 13th at 2:00 pm in St. Columba Cathedral in Youngstown,** honoring couples observing their 25th, 40th, 50th, and over wedding anniversaries in 2021. There will be another Wedding Anniversary Celebration in the fall.

The Wedding Anniversary Celebration will include Mass celebrated by Bishop David J. Bonnar, renewal of marriage vows and a personalized certificate for each couple.

Couples celebrating anniversaries have two options:
1) They may attend the Wedding Anniversary Celebration Mass "in person" at St. Columba cathedral.

2) They may participate "remotely" via livestreaming of the Mass through the Diocese of Youngstown's website at www.doy.org. (in which case their certificate will be mailed to them). Limited spaces are available for couples attending in person at the cathedral.

Because of COVID-19 only couples celebrating anniversaries may attend. Unfortunately, families and other guests cannot attend, and there will be no reception afterwards. Please keep in mind that one or both spouses must be Catholic and the marriage must be recognized by the Church. **Reservations must be made for this celebration by contacting the rectory office by May 12th.**
